NOTIFICATION OF CADET OFFICER TRAINING **ADVERTISEMENT – 2022**

Applications are invited from serving members of Royal Papua New Guinea Constabulary for the Officer Cadet Training Program at the National Centre of Excellence – Bomana, starting in May, 2023. The potential candidate must:

1. Be a confirmed serving member of the Constabulary with a minimum of five (5) years' service.
2. Be between 25 – 35 years of age.
3. Be physically fit and healthy and of sober character (tests and checks will be required)
4. Have no disciplinary charges (MDOR and SDOR) within the last two (2) years and no pending charges.
5. Be single or married with only one (1) spouse
6. A Diploma or Degree from a tertiary institution would be viewed favourably but minimum is grade 12 school leavers certificate with grade C in English and Math
7. Have supporting recommendation from PPC or Director
8. Must not be an ex-cadet removed from a previous Officer Cadet course.

The selection criteria supersede all other instruments or correspondences issued previously that are pertinent to the recruitment of Cadet Officer for the Constabulary.

9. To be included in applications are the following documents:

- a. A cover letter expressing your interest and
- b. Your Curriculum Vitae
